Businessman Found Beheaded

The owner of a Boston based medical company, Franklin Rosenthal, was killed this Tuesday in a freak accident in his driveway. Rosenthal was taking a shopping bag from his car trunk when the trunk lid slammed shut. Rosenthal's head was cut off and he died instantly.

Rosenthal was found lying dead by his housemate, Rev. David Irons the same night. "It was a horrible sight. Frank was lying next to the car with his head missing," Irons describes. "I opened the trunk, and that's where I saw his head."

Police coroner, Anne Newman, did not comment on the event any further, but does not deny the possibility of homicide.

Rosenthal was known as a brilliant businessman, and a philanthropist who personally transported medical aid to the Middle East.
